NCCD combines data analysis expertise with extensive content knowledge to provide insights to social service agencies about how to improve outcomes for the individuals and families they serve. The data scientist will work with the research and analysis team, the social services practice team, and the technology services team to manage projects that integrate and use data from multiple social service agency databases.

The data scientist's specific tasks will include researching statistical learning models for data analysis, working with analytic platforms such as R or Python, and identifying which data are available and relevant.
